Brownies

2 sticks + 2 Tbsp butter, melted 5 eggs
¼ c. cocoa ½ tsp salt
2 ¼ c. sugar 2 ½ tsp vanilla
1 c. + 2 Tbsp flour ¾ tsp baking powder

- Combine melted butter, sugar, eggs, and vanilla. Mix well.
- Add cocoa, salt, flour, and baking powder. Mix well to create thick batter.
- Pour batter into a prepared 9x13 pan.
- Bake at 350° for 25-30 minutes, until firm to the touch.
