### **Chicken Gnocchi Soup**

1 onion, diced	4 ribs of celery, diced
3 carrots, diced	8 chicken breasts, cooked and diced
4 cups frozen gnocchi dumplings	½ lb butter
½ cup flour	1 gal chicken stock
salt/pepper/garlic/thyme to taste	2 cups half & half
1 cup parmesan cheese	8 basil leaves, chiffonade

- Melt butter in saucepan
- Add vegetables and seasonings; cook for 5 minutes
- Add flour; cook to make roux
- Add chicken and chicken stock
- Bring to boil, and add gnocchis; continue to cook until thickened
- Remove from heat; add basil, half & half, and parmesan cheese
