From The Kitchen

Chocolate Chip Cookies

2 sticks butter, softened
2 eggs
3 c. flour
½ tsp. Salt
2 c. brown sugar
1 Tbsp. vanilla
1 tsp. Baking soda
1 1/2 c. chocolate chips

- Cream together butter, sugar, eggs, and vanilla until light and fluffy
- Sift together flour, baking soda, and salt
- Add creamed mixture to the dry, and mix together
- Add chocolate chips and mix well
- Scoop onto lined cookie sheet
- Bake at 350° for 8 - 10 minutes, until lightly browned on the bottoms


