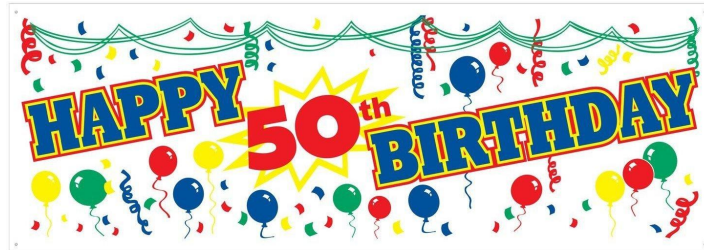

## From The Kitchen

### Baked French Toast Casserole

We make this Christmas morning every year at our house. Makes for a special yet easy to prepare breakfast for everyone!

1 loaf, thick sliced Italian bread  
1 1/2 c. half and half  
1 tsp. Vanilla extract  
1 package bacon

1 dozen eggs  
1 tsp. Cinnamon  
1 stick butter, melted  
1/2 c. brown sugar

- Beat eggs, add vanilla, cinnamon, and half and half. Mix well.

- Layer bread slices in 9x13 baking pan.
- Drizzle melted butter over top of bread.
- Pour egg batter over bread in pan, and press down slightly to absorb batter into bread
- Chop bacon into small pieces. Cook over medium heat in pan on the stove, draining grease as needed until crisp.
- Combine bacon pieces with brown sugar to make topping.
- Sprinkle topping over bread. Drizzle with remaining bacon grease.
- Cover pan with foil, and bake in 350°F for 30 minutes.
- Remove foil and bake an addition 30 minutes, until firm but not dry to the touch
- Allow to rest. Slice into squares to serve, and top with maple syrup.

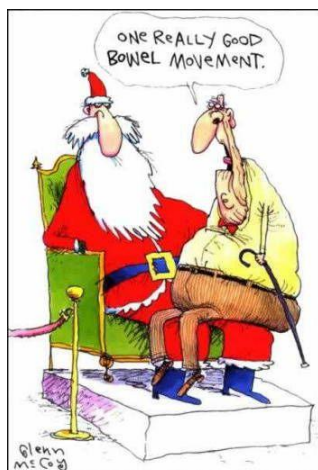
